

What Parents Need to Know:

FAQs for Club Year 2025-2026

1. What is Awana Cubbies?

- To find out about Cubbies, be sure to watch the Cubbies parent video at www.southlife.org/awana
- Awana Cubbies is a weekly Bible-based club program for preschoolers. It features Scripture memorization and basic Bible truths preschoolers can understand. The program materials assist and encourage parents to actively participate in their child's spiritual development.
- In addition to the important Biblical teaching, our Cubbies enjoy getting to know their table leader and friends by playing together and doing activities which support the truth of the night. They sing and enjoy a snack together.

2. When do Cubbies meet?

- Time: Awana meets on Wednesday evenings from 6:30 8:00 p.m. Clubbers are not to be dropped off until 6:20 p.m. and picked up promptly at 8:00 p.m.
- Awana begins on September 10, 2025 and concludes with our Awards Ceremony on April 29, 2026.

3. What is the cost?

- The registration fee is \$12 per clubber and helps cover awards.
- You will need to purchase the required handbook (\$13) and Cubbie Vest (\$15). These should be brought/worn every week. Throughout the year, your child earns patches which are put on their vest.
- If you have a financial hardship, please let us know as we do have scholarships available.
- Books and supplies are available through the Awana Office in the South Life Center, before and during Club. Items can also be ordered online (southlife.org/awana) and picked up in the Awana Office.

4. Where does my child go?

- Park on the east side of the building (covered entrance) for quickest access to children's ministry
- Check-in: All children must be checked it at a kiosk to receive name label and parent claim ticket. Children are then dropped off and picked up in their classroom by an adult with the claim ticket.

Younger Cubbies (age 3 by September 1, 2025) meet in Room 134 Older Cubbies (age 4 by September 1, 2025) meet in Room 209.

5. What will Cubbies do at Awana?

- Crafts and play time
- Bible lesson with puppets and music
- Game time
- Table time to say verse and have snack

6. What is my involvement as a parent?

- We require a parent (or adult representative) to be in the building all during Awana, in case there is an
 emergency.
- We request all parents to help in providing the weekly snack. There will be a snack sign-up sheet at the check-in table. Please let us know if your child has food allergies.
- Check your child's book for the calendar of which pages we are working on and the meeting schedule.

7. What about snow days?
