- How to work together for the gospel
- How to help someone come and see Jesus
- How to ask questions and answer hard questions

As we spend time reviewing scripture, articles, book snippets and other material, we'll have time for discussion and sharing. This is an interactive class so come prepared to ask questions, share knowledge and listen actively! We are excited to see how God will shape us and challenge us during our time together, and excited to watch Him work in the lives of those around us.
