You will be challenged to encounter the God of the Bible who exists for His own glory, and whose plans are not thwarted! We hope to discuss and answer the following questions:

- What does God reveal to us about the nations in His Word?
- What does the Bible say about local and global missions?
- How can we know if we should be personally involved in missions?
- What did the 2022 Missions Conference Projects support?
- What is it like to be a missionary?
- How do you become a missionary?
- What does the missions board do?
- What is a sending agency?
- What is a sender and how does the Bible address senders?

- We will have the opportunity to learn from and interact with some of the missionaries South Supports!
- We will offer training and opportunity to be mentored and serve here in the Lansing so that you can put into practice what you learn in the class.
- We will take time to discuss and answer your questions!
