



Crucial Questions for Christian Living in a Changing World – SF 102

Society and culture are changing rapidly – so what does this mean for the individual Christian and for the church? How do we live as “salt and light” (Matt. 5:13-16), combining grace and truth as we engage the world around us? And in what particular ways does the church need to be revived and renewed by God’s Word to remain faithful to the Lord and to its calling and mission? These are the kinds of concerns we will explore together from Scripture.

TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Whatever happened to Truth (and is there ‘Right and Wrong’ that applies to everyone)?
- What are the fundamental mis-beliefs at work in our culture today?
- Why can I still be confident in the Bible as God’s Word?
- What does it mean to worship and serve God in my everyday life (in my family, job and neighborhood)?
- What is God’s plan for the Church?
- How should our commitment to evangelism connect with our concern for promoting justice and compassion in our overall ministry as Christians?
- What should our message and ministry be to those involved in ‘alternative lifestyles’?
- How should I live out my ‘dual citizenship’ (as an American and a Christian [Phil. 3:20]), including in the area of politics?

Our teaching and discussion time will focus on Biblical passages relating to these questions, along with recommended resources (books, articles from the web, etc.).
