DEVELOPING RELATIONSHIPS

Love has this contextual bed-fellow in Scripture; it is neighbor in both the Greek and Latin. Neighbor means to draw near. Near - not just geographically BUT - personally and spiritually

VI. TO BE A NEIGHBOR IS TO DEVELOP A CAPACITY TO DRAW NEAR.

Four basic approaches to culture:

Culture defined: Culture is a body of ready made solutions to the challenges, tensions, and problems of life.

Four responses:

- 1. Rejection Radical Difference (no radical identification)
- 2. Immersion Radical Identification (No radical difference)
- 3. Split-Adaptation
- 4. Critical Participation

God has not called us out of cultures, but He placed us within culture to be light and salt.
